Pre-Anesthetic Blood Testing Consent Form

**PLEASE BRING THIS FORM WITH
YOU THE DAY OF THE SURGERY**

Like you, our greatest concern is the well-being of your pet. Before putting your pet under anesthesia, we will perform a full physical examination. However, many conditions, including disorders of the liver, kidneys or blood, are not detected unless blood testing is performed. Such tests are especially important before any kind of surgery.

For these reasons, we highly recommend blood screening before such procedures. The total cost of these important tests is: \$ 39.78 + tax

Our laboratory is fully equipped and staffed to perform these important blood tests. Results will be immediately available to examine before anesthesia and/or surgery. Please indicate your choice below:

PLEASE BRING WITH YOU THE DAY OF THE SURGERY

If fleas are found upon admittance we will automatically treat your cat by administering 1 application of Capstar (\$4.99) at the owners expense to prevent further infestation to your cat and other cats in the hospital. If fleas are found we also treat with a monthly application of revolution (\$13.50) at the owners expense.

If your cat has been declawed we recommend that they be given shredded paper or yesterdays news in their litterbox in place of their regular litter, until the Dr. has seen them for their recheck exam in 7 – 10 days from the time of the surgery.

This letter is to confirm that your pet is scheduled for surgery / or a dental. Our surgery check-in time is between 8 am – 8:30 am the day of the procedure. Enclosed please find a surgery release / pre-anesthetic testing form. Please read and complete this form and bring it with you when you drop your cat(s) off for surgery. Pre-anesthetic bloodwork gives the Doctor an inside look at some of your pet's vital internal organs. We are especially concerned with the health of the liver and kidneys as these organs help the body get rid of the medications used during anesthesia. **We strongly recommend** doing this simple bloodwork to help insure the safety of your cat.

PRE-SURGERY CHECKLIST

- Remove all food after 9 p.m. the night before your cats procedure
- Remove water the morning of your cats procedure
- **Sign & bring surgery Pre-anesthetic testing form the morning of the procedure**

Pre-anesthetic screening reduces the risk of anesthesia to its lowest level. Your cat will receive an analgesic injection to minimize any discomfort that might be experienced post-surgery.
